



Reem Ghuniam Announced as New Executive Director

Fields of Peace's Board of Directors welcomes Reem Ghunaim as its new executive director. Reem was selected to develop strategies to evolve the organization's mission into catalyzing a global peace-building movement inspired and driven by children of conflict.

As her primary focus, Reem will work to increase the resilience of children in conflict zones. She aims to work with on-the-ground partners to support children in reaching their full potential and leading the way for peace in their regions of conflict and across borders.



The first program with schools in Cameroon is currently developing in collaboration with the International Governance Institute-Cameroon. As Executive Director, Ms. Ghunaim is dedicated to transforming lives, communities, and the world through the power of children and the tools of peace education.

Prior to joining Fields of Peace, Reem was the International Outreach & Development Deputy for Solidarity 2020 and Beyond. There she supported and advanced the work of 75 grassroots movements in over 40 countries.

Earlier she served as Executive Director for Rotary Action Group for Peace, leading the expansion and strengthening of their network of community leaders through various programs that were internationally acclaimed. Through her efforts, the organization's outreach expanded from 20 countries to over 125 countries.

Reem is the recipient of various awards including the 2021 Global Peace and Humanitarian Award in recognition of her international peacebuilding work. Her academic journey included attaining a Rotary Peace Fellowship at the Duke-UNC Rotary Peace Center (2012-2014). During this experience, she earned her master's degree in city and Regional Planning and a certificate in International Peace and Conflict Resolution.

She is a Positive Peace Activator and a Global Peace Index Ambassador for the Institute for Economics and Peace, the leading think tank on measuring global peace. Additionally, Reem has served on the boards of several international organizations including Hands of Peace and Combatants for Peace.

Reem states that her personal mission is to dismantle stereotypes and elevate the voices of the oppressed by cultivating mutual understanding, promoting Positive Peace, and protecting Human Rights for all.
